What is the role of a TA?

Teaching Assistants will be working closely with Expert faculty.

What are the responsibilities of an TA?

As an TA, you are expected to:

- To work under the direct supervision of expert faculty, to support access to learning for pupils and provide general support to the faculty in the management of students and the classroom.
- Supervise and support student learning, both in classrooms as well as in their projects.
- Establish good relationships with students, acting as a role model and being aware of and responding appropriately to individual needs.
- Encourage students to interact with others and engage in activities led by the faculty.
- Be aware of student problems/progress/achievements and report to the faculty.
- Undertake student record keeping.
- Support students to understand and follow instructions.
- Participate in training and other learning activities and performance development as required.
- Assist with the coordination and supervision of students out of lesson times, including before and after class hours.
- Attend relevant meetings as required.

How do you benefit as an Intern?

- All TA are eligible for a stipend.
- Work experience certificate will be provided
- Opportunity to develop training and leadership skills.
- Opportunity to network, interact & learn from industry mentors.

What is the Eligibility Criteria to become a TA?

- Should have 0-2 years experience.
- Should have successfully completed a certification course or / and have work experience in the relevant teaching areas.
